



Helpful tips to know when sowing Wesco Seed:

- ▶ Ensuring your seed is planted at the correct depth is critical to plant survival. We recommend no more than 15mm deep. For White Clover seed we recommend 10mm, no deeper as this can reduce the germination rate by up to 50%.
- ▶ Study your soil type and use this as a guide for planting seed. If the soil is dry, plant seed deeper to ensure that its in the more moist zone of the soil and if soil is wet plant seed closer to the surface.
- ▶ Calibrate drill for each paddock and CHECK how deep the seed is going. If you are using a contractor check how they are drilling as well, as this seed is the future of your farm!
- ▶ Record all conditions after planting such as soil moisture, drill settings, ground temperature and weather to establish your own personal farm guide.
- ▶ Always make sure your seed bed is firm, if it is fluffy roll it again before sowing. It is ideal to keep the seed bed rolled between cultivation passes to help retain moisture and prevent organic matter loss. If you are getting a wave in front of your roller, stop sowing and roll the paddock again. Have you ever noticed the seed seems to establish faster on the head lands or where the tractor has driven? This is because of a firmer seed bed.


